

# 35th Annual Alberta Junior Angus Show Olds, AB July 14-16, 2010



## Rules and Guidelines

1. **Entry Fee** : \$25 per class up to **June 4, 2010** after and up to **June 18, 2010** \$40 per class
2. Show is open to juniors world wide, 21 years and under as of January 1, 2010. Animals must be **owned** by exhibitor at time of entry (unless entered in the Tiny Mite, Pee Wee or Open Class).
3. **Copy of the registration form should accompany the entry form. All cattle including calendar year calves MUST be registered to be eligible to show.** Tattoos must be legible. Bring original papers to the show for verification.
4. The AJAA and/or Olds Ag Society and/or members are not responsible for accident or loss.
5. **Adult participation is forbidden.** Ask the show committee if you require help.
6. Animals may only be shown in **one** class (excluding Tiny Mite & Pee Wee classes).
7. One entry form per exhibitor.
8. Tiny Mites & Pee Wee's show in the classes in their respective age division only. Animals can be purebred or commercial.

## Commercial Cattle

1. Must show **strong** ANGUS characteristics.
2. Commercial cattle may only show in **ONE** commercial Breed class at Summer Synergy.
3. They are eligible for the CS Jackpot class.

## Competitions to enter at the show...

**Individual Judging** - oral reasons - 3 Classes will be judged by Juniors & Seniors  
Tiny Mites will judge one class & Pee Wee's will judge two classes. Judging is **Mandatory**.

**Showmanship** - will be judged during the conformation classes and individuals (2 or more at the judges discretion) will advance out of each class and will be able to compete at the end for the final showmanship in each age category.

**Team Judging** - teams are designated before the individual competition & scores from individual judging competition will be added together - top three team scores advance to the FINALS in Pee Wee, Junior & Senior

**Sales Talk** – all ages (topic given at show)

**Print Marketing** - all ages (topic given at show)

**Photography** - you will be given a camera & 20 minutes to get your BEST SHOT, they will then be judged on quality of content, clarity, unique technique, overall impression... there will be a sign up sheet for time slots at registration.

### **AJAA Creative Components:**

You can bring as many as you like, but one in each category must be designated to be judged

All creative components must include **Angus or Angus influenced material**

**\*\*BRING WITH YOU TO THE SHOW COMPLETED\*\***

**Literature** – *Original work created by the exhibitor.*

Poetry – Pee Wee, Junior or Senior

Story (fiction or non-fiction) – Pee Wee, Junior or Senior

**Flat Artwork** – *Original work created by the exhibitor.*

Flat (Examples - pencil, paper, paint, etc) – Pee Wee, Junior or Senior

3-Dimensional (Examples - wood, clay etc) – Pee Wee, Junior or Senior

**Scrapbook** – *Original work created by the exhibitor.*

*The scrapbook contest is used to encourage junior members to keep a record of the different cattle functions they have been to over the past year. It can also be used to educate other juniors what things are like around your farm through the year.*

Examples - Angus, junior activities or beef industry
