Rules and Guidelines

1. **Entry Fee** : \$15 per class up to May 31, 2006;
Late entry \$30 per class
2. Show is open to juniors world wide, under 21 years as of January 1, 2006. Animals must be owned by Juniors (unless entered in the Open Class).
3. Copy of the registration form should accompany the entry form. Tattoos must be legible.
4. The AJAA and/or Olds Ag Society and/ or members are not responsible for accident or loss.
5. **Adult participation is forbidden.**
6. Animals may only be shown in **one** class. Unless participant is a freshman or sophomore, in which case, the animal will be entered in both freshman or sophomore and one other conformation class.
7. Please list all juniors who will be participating at the show on individual forms.

Conformation Classes (enter class by letter on entry form)

Freshman – first time entrants and graduating Pee Wee

Sophomore – second time entrants only

- a. **Tiny Mites** – Calendar year calves from entrants 5 years and under as of Jan. 1/06
- b. **Pee Wee** – owned by 6-9 year old
 - i. 2006 heifer calf
 - ii. 2006 bull calf
 - iii. Yearling Heifer
 - iv. 2 yr. old female
- c. **Open class** – owned by anyone shown by junior
 - i. 2006 heifer calf
 - ii. 2006 bull calf
 - iii. Yearling Heifer
 - iv. 2 yr. old female
- d. **Bred & Owned** Yearling heifer – Registration papers must carry entrant as breeder and owner of the animal.
- e. **Junior- Yearling** heifer must be owned by junior (10-21yrs) by June 1/06
- f. **2 year old** – owned by junior (10-21 yrs) by June 1/06
- g. **Mature Female** – 3 yrs & older – owned by junior(10-21yrs) by June 1/06
- h. **2006 Heifer Calf** – owned by junior by June 1/06
- i. **2006 Bull Calf** - owned by Junior by June 1/06
- j. **Futurity Bull** – yearling & 2 year old – bred and owned by junior
- k. **Commercial- yearling heifer-** owned by junior by June 1/06
- l. **Commercial-** 2 year olds owned by junior by June 1/06
- m. **Commercial Mature Cow** – owned by Junior by June 1/06

AJAA Creative Components:

(there is only one category in each and must include Angus or Angus influence)

Photography – Angus animal, scenery and Angus, people with Angus etc.

Literature – poetry, fiction, non- fiction etc.

Flat Artwork – pencil, paper, etc.

3 Dimensional Artwork – wood, clay etc.
